

Small Garden Kit

Tools required sledge hammer.

1. Kit contains 100 x 7.5 foot standard fence
2. 8 posts
3. 8 sleeves
4. 8 post caps
5. 8 ground stakes
6. 50 Fence ties
7. Fence tying tool.
8. Sleeve driving tool
9. Pack of white ribbons.

Creating a simple gate.

- Select two posts in your layout the width you wish the gate to be.
- When installing the mesh fix to one and overlap a flap 1 foot beyond the other post
- Secure the gate (flap) with caribina's top , bottom and middle.

Installation Steps

- Layout fence rectangle or square
- Drive corner sleeves into ground first, use post to check for vertical when sleeve is halfway in.
- Attach fence to first post with fence ties.
- Use 5-6 ties per posts per tree or post.
- Pull mesh to next post.
- Stand on the bottom two squares so that bottom points out towards the deer.
- Attach mesh with fence ties , continue around perimeter.
- Between posts fix mesh to ground with ground stakes to prevent the deer from getting underneath the fence.
- Attach white ribbons every 6-8 feet around the fence.
- Leave the ribbons in place for 3 months to train the deer to walk around the perimeter of the fence.
- Keep gate closed or the deer will get in!!
